

# Records tumble at annual round meeting

Dolphins competed in the last of the Speedo League held at High. The competition was really tough. The Dolphins never failed to set five new club records being the night.

Liam (13) swam well to set two new records by finishing second in the 100m breast (1.20.25s) and – in the group – fourth in the 100m IM. Ben also swam in the 100m fly to set a new club record (1.17.63).

A great performance was delivered by Luke Walsh, who set a new club record in the 100m breaststroke by winning in a time of 1.16.82s. Luke also set a new club record in the 100m fly (1.05.76).

Teamed up with Daniel Clucas, Shepherd-Barns and Liam Osborne, the 15&U freestyle relay race team smashed the club record by winning in a time of 1.50.74s.

A new club record of the night was set by a quartet Luke Walsh, Daniel Clucas, Murray Burt and Liam Osborne, who claimed a victory in the 15&U freestyle relay (2.07.91).

Dean (10) gained a first place in the 50m fly (38.71), while 14-year-old Luke Forester won the 100m fly

Open swimmer Sam Rate finished sixth in the 100m fly and James Martin did likewise in the breaststroke.
